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Supply of Frisium 10mg Tablet (batch number 5NP6A and 5NP7C) with deficient labelling on carton

3 December 2025

Dear Healthcare Professional,

The Marketing Authorisation Holder, Atnahs Pharma UK LTD, wishes to inform you about a labelling issue concerning certain batches of Frisium 10mg Tablets, batch numbers 5NP6A and 5NP7C, currently being supplied.

Due to the Windsor Framework, certain batches of Frisium 10mg Tablets, specifically batch numbers 5NP6A and 5NP7C, are being distributed with deficient labelling, as they are missing the "UK only" label.

- Despite this deficiency, these batches are confirmed to be legitimate, licensed medicinal products.
- The quality, safety, and efficacy of the product are not affected.

The product can continue to be dispensed as usual. The MHRA has permitted this product for use within deficient packaging to mitigate supply shortages.

Please continue to report suspected adverse drug reactions (ADRs) to the MHRA through the Yellow Card scheme.
